Ages: Academy Soccer is for ages U8-U12.

Practices: Academy and Select Soccer take your athlete to another level through paid trainers,
more practices and a broader range of competition. Practices will still be picked by the head
volunteer coaches at one of the local Fulton county school sites. Times will still held be held
after working hours and for 1-1.5 hrs, 2x a week. There will be a 3rd option of free skills clinics
available during the season (TBD).

Games and Opponents: Some may be asking what the differences are between Rec and
Academy. This is a program designed to give that little bit of extra TLC to the sport your child
loves. Extra practices, paid trainers at every practice, exposure to additional teams and and the
advantage of having affordable competition.

Your season will run the same time as other soccer season; August-November and March-May. You
are allotted a minimum of 8 games and a max of 10 (based on rainouts). You will have an even
split of home vs away games. Your opponents will be local area academy teams of your caliber as
well; i.e. Ambush, Stars, Concord, Cherokee Impact, etc.
