Cards

As a benefit of membership, your children, ages 5-12, may utilize the Play Center. To register your child, you must obtain a family facility membership card in the Tour Office on your first visit.

Sign in/Sign Out

Please sign in your child and note the time. You must stay on the premises if you have your child in this program area. If they are age appropriate, your child is allowed to leave on their own accord to use another program area. If your child is disruptive or inappropriate, we will notify you so you may come and help your child.
