TIME LIMIT

Children may be left for up to two hours a day and seven hours per week. Because we are trying to accommodate many children, your cooperation regarding time is appreciated. **CPC is free to children who are facility members.**

SIGN IN/SIGN OUT

Please give your child's card to the nursery attendant. Sign your child(ren) in and note the time and where you will be in the facility in case we need to speak with you. You will be given a numbered button and your child a name tag with your number and time of check in.

If your child cries or seems distressed for more than ten minutes, we will call you on the intercom so that you may come and help the child.

You must remain on the YMCA premises at all time when using the nursery. This is in the best interest of your child.

Must be 18 years or older to sign children into the CPC.



MEMBERSHIP CARDS

As a benefit of membership, ages 6-12, may utilize the Play Center. To register your child, you must obtain a Family Facility Membership card at the membership desk on your first visit.

KIDS ONLY, PLEASE

Parents are not permitted in the play center at anytime during regular hours.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Three or four of these activities will be available each day.

Imagination Station

Children will create and design their own arts and crafts projects. Their creations will be based on seasonal and holiday themes along with a variety of other subjects.

Game Safari

Children will actively engage in group games, ping pong, foosball and air hockey with the focus being on team building and cooperation.

The Reader's Zone

Children will read a variety of titles as well as those books brought from home will be the focus in this station.

Get your Game on

Toy and board games are played in this station. A variety of education toys are available for all ages.

Study Zone

This space is designated for children to complete homework.

Matrix Reloaded

Our computers are loaded with a fun, yet educational software at this station.

ILLNESS/CONTAGIOUS CONDITIONS

Any child who appears to have any illness or contagious condition including but not limited to cold or cough, diarrhea or vomiting, nasal or ear discharge, fever, contagious rashes (chicken pox, impetigo, fifth disease) or head lice - will be asked to be removed from our CPC. The child cannot return until he/she is symptom free or has a doctor's note stating that the child is no longer contagious. In any case, sick children should not return for 48 hours. YMCA staff will not distribute medication.

TIME OUT

This is the only form of discipline used in our CPC. Any child who shows aggressive behavior such as the use of foul language, dangerous play or fighting will be suspended for two weeks or termination of membership privileges. The YMCA expects members and guests to behave in an appropriate manner.

Members will be held responsible for the conduct of any guests they bring to the YMCA.

IN THE EVENT OF AN EVACUATION

Parents should report to the CPC evacuation area as soon as they are safely out of the building. The evacuation area is located to the left of the main entrance. Our staff has been thoroughly trained on emergency procedures and will assist members and children in the event of an emergency. You will be able to sign your child out, if you so choose, at this location.
