## Swim Lesson Policies:

1. If your child has not celebrated their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, they must wear CDC approved pants or a swim diaper with vinyl covering (CDC approved pants can be purchased at the registration desk for \$10.00).
2. Cancellations must be made 4 business days prior to the first class. No refund will be given after these days as we will be unable to offer the spot to another swimmer. **All cancellations must be in written form** through registration desk or email. No cancellations accepted by phone.
3. Non-attendance does not entitle you to a refund or credit. Refunds and credits will not be given for vacations, illness, etc. Special circumstances should be presented to the Aquatic Department for consideration.
4. In the case of thunder/lighting storms, we will not conduct class in the water due to safety. However, our program includes components that can be taught on land then applied in the water. If more than 20 minutes of a preschool class or 30 minutes of a youth class is conducted in the water, the class will not be subjected to a make-up or credit.
