

Gymnastics Camp (ages 5-12)

Camp Discovery Teen Camps

Trailblazers (Age 11-13): Our teen Trailblazer program offers a variety of wilderness and adventure experiences for youth ages 11-13. Each session is designed to gradually build comfort and skills in the outdoors while encouraging growth in key areas that are vital in the transition into adulthood. The challenges presented daily provide lessons in good judgment, and decision-making, group and self-reliance and personal responsibility.

Teen/Leaders in Training program (L.I.T.) (Ages 14-16)

LIT's will take leadership roles and assist counselors with daily camp activities. This group will also be in charge of the Camp Discovery Planning Committee which helps coordinate and design activities/projects for the weekly camp themes.
