Bill McKoy is the Senior VP of Operations of the YMCA of Metro Atlanta. He provides leadership to the Covington, The Villages at Carver and Young Family YMCAs and supervises sports programs for the association. He also serves as executive director of the Decatur Family YMCA.

The 2015 Decatur Family YMCA renovation and expansion were 10 years in the process, during which Bill planned and oversaw the \$5 million project. He built a successful partnership with the Clarkston Community Center to include refugees and new immigrants in Y programs. He established a wellness program for DeKalb County Health Department patients and a membership program for teachers in the DeKalb County School System. In 2005, he developed a partnership with the Decatur City School System that helped launch the College Heights Early Learning Center, a center that supports the development of children ages 0-3 and provides pre-K education programs. In 1998, Bill co-founded the Happy Club, a social and recreational program for adults with developmental disabilities.

In his career with the YMCA of Metro Atlanta, he served as director of metro teen programs and executive director at the Robert D. Fowler YMCA in Peachtree Corners. Along with Guy Millner, he co-founded the Y-CEO Heritage Invitational Golf Tournament.

A native of North Carolina, Bill earned a bachelor's degree from Purdue University. Prior to joining the Y, he played football for the San Francisco 49ers and Denver Broncos. He is a graduate of Leadership DeKalb.

Bill and his wife, Pamela, reside in Mableton, Georgia. They have one adult son and a granddaughter. When he is not spending time with his family, Bill enjoys traveling, golfing and flying model planes.
